

In 1996 Peter Goldring became involved in public life as the founder of the Western Canadian branch of the Special Committee for Canadian Unity (SCCU). He successfully ran for Parliament in Edmonton East in 1997 on a platform for Canadian Unity and standing up against the separatists. With the 2012 return of the separatist Parti Quebecois to power in Quebec national unity is at the forefront once more.

On June 30th, 2013, the day before

Canada Day, hundreds of people gathered in front of the downtown Montreal office of Quebec Premier Pauline Marois to proudly proclaim that they are and will remain Canadian. Mr. Goldring joined with some Canadian patriots he has known since his days with the SCCU: activist and broadcaster Howard Galganov. lawyer Brent Tyler and former Equality leader Keith Party

Henderson, joining with them to have their
collective voices heard. Also speaking at the
rally were Jimmy Kay, Kader Singh and Jim

Duff, more proud Canadian patriots.

Keith Henderson told the crowd the situation for Anglophones and Allophones in Quebec under a separatist government is one of the denial of rights by that government. He likened the situation to that of Afro-Americans in the southern United States in the 1950s. "We have got to get our rights back!" he stated, comparing Quebec premier Pauline Marois to French Empress Marie Antoinette in the days prior to the French Revolution. "I would say to Pauline Mariois,

we have voted twice to stay in Canada – quit dividing us!"

According to Peter Goldring: "The rally's purpose was to put Canadian rights back in Quebec, calling for federal government intervention when Canadian rights in Quebec are denied by the provincial government."

When Mr. Goldring first began working with Howard Galganov on unity

issues, Howard was a popular Montreal radio talk show host and strong advocate for

Canadian unity and standing up against the separatist threats in Quebec, including teaming up with Mr. Goldring on several very contentious issues to push back against the separatist's political agenda, including a large rally in Quebec City to protest the insult of Canadian Veterans and Canada's former wartime Prime Minister, Mackenzie King. Most recently, Howard describes himself as an "angryphone," and to those who suggest

he is an extremist he replies: "If you are not extreme protecting your own rights and the rights of others, then what are you?" He also told the rally: "If you are not prepared to go to the mat for your own Canadian rights, then you don't deserve to have them".

Mr. Goldring felt that it was an honour to share the stage with these Canadian patriots and to provide some encouragement to

those who came out to the rally. Anglophones in Quebec at times feel under siege. not welcome in their home province, despite roots going back more than 250 years. All too often, rather than cause a confrontation, Canadians have chosen the path of appeasement when it comes to the separatists in Quebec. It is time to put an end to this pandering to a relatively small, self-serving separatist group who want all the benefits of being Canadian without any of the attendant responsibilities; particularly, adherence to Canada's Charter of Rights and Freedoms.

The following is the essence of Peter Goldring's speech at the event.

"I am honoured to stand before you as a fellow Canadian.

"Sixteen years ago, as a newly minted Canadian Parliamentarian, I stood with

Howard Galganov in Van Horne Park - to help quell the lies of separatism. Van Horne Park glowed with Canadianism at the first Canada Day celebration in its history. Horseback Mounted Montreal Police proudly raced with the Canadian flag across the park the delight of

ada Day, now as a veteran Member of Canada's Parliament to add my voice, to proclaim, WE ARE CANA-DIAN! I AM CANADIAN! But how far have we come since then?"

I want to close with words that I believe describes our Canadian Unity.

"We, the people

of Canada, proclaim with pride that we are and wish to remain, with the aid of God, a people free and responsible for our destiny. Born of the encounter of the English fact and the French fact on North American soil, ancestral home of the native populations and enriched by the contribution of millions of new Canadians from the four corners of the globe, we wish to live, beyond the frontiers of race, language and religion, a common adventure of economic and cultural

sharing, in the respect of our diversity."

Thank you all for coming here today and supporting Canada. God bless Canada.

It is important to draw public attention to the excesses of radical separatist. The separatist fervor in extremist linguistic and cultural cleansing is making them the butt of jokes around the world. What the extremists separatists don't seem to realize is that the Québécois culture was nourished and created by the hundreds of others of the world's cultures that enjoined the French with the Aboriginals in Canada. The French Canadian language is not even nearly Parisian French but is a Québécois Patois as a result of the multiculturalism in Canada.

**UPDATE:** In 2002, Bill 99 was challenged in court by Equality Party leader Keith Henderson, who contended that THE Bill was unconstitutional. In October 2013, the Harper government requested intervenor status in the case, contending that "Secession, to be lawful, would require a constitutional amendment."
